ABSTRACT SUBMISSION (ABSTRACT SUBMISSION DEADLINE IS 31ST AUGUST 2016)

Basic science Research, clinical Abstracts including Case reports and Clinical audits are invited to be submitted.

Key points towards a successful Abstract submission:

- 1) Read the Abstract submission Guidelines first.
- 2) Reviewers First score is for Originality
- 3) Next Scoring Criteria is Scientific Merit. Your Abstract must demonstrate your study to be scientifically sound.
- 4) To increase your chances of a successful submission, ensure that someone with publication expertise in your department/hospital has reviewed your Abstract before submitting.
- 5) All submissions should ensure complete patient confidentiality and anonymity.
- 6) For Non-English speaking writers, we recommend having your submission reviewed by a native English Speaker before submission
- 7) Abstract conclusions should be consistent with results from your study.
- 8) Take Note of the Abstract submission Deadline to avoid disappointment. Submission Deadline Date is : **31st AUGUST 2017**

E-Poster Presentation

- dedicated poster viewing time in the Exhibit hall within the program schedule
- great platform for one on one discussion with delegates
- longer exposure than with oral/video presentations
- 3' high x 6' wide (max.) poster with graphs and tables

Video Presentation

- demonstrates techniques or procedures that are often time-consuming or difficult to explain
- must not be longer than 8 minutes with titles and a spoken narrative
