ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

General Background

An abstract is an outline/brief summary of your paper and your whole project in well-developed paragraph, and must be understandable to a wide audience. The abstracts should be no more than 350 words, formatted in Microsoft Word, and single-spaced, using size 12 Arial font.

If your abstract title includes scientific notation, Greek letters, bold, italics, or other special characters/symbols, do make sure they appear correctly. List all authors including any additional undergraduate co-authors, if applicable.

The Abstract should have the following information

- The purpose of the project identifying the area of study to which it belongs.
- The research problem that motivates the project.
- The methods used to address this research problem, documents or evidence analyzed.
- The conclusions reached or, if the research is in progress, what the preliminary results of the investigation suggest, or what the research methods demonstrate.
- The significance of the research project. Why are the results useful? What is new to our understanding as the result of your inquiry?
